

PRIMARY SCHOOL SPORTS PREMIUM FUNDING 2017/18

Currently the Government provides national funding to help improve the quality and provision of physical education and school sport in primary schools. In the academic year 2017/18 Wraysbury Primary School will receive a PE Grant of £19,320. Schools have the freedom to choose how they spend this money. Here at Wraysbury Primary School we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well- being of the children. Detailed below is the proposed spending for the PE grant in the academic year 2017/18 and the intended impact upon our pupils.
