SATs Y2

These continue next week and again a huge well done to the children for their hard work and resilience. A reminder, please do not book any medical visits such as dental appointments or

arrange any other absence during this time. The teachers work extremely hard to ensure that the SATs are administered in a supportive way which means grouping the children in small groups or 1:1s and ensuring that there are appropriate staff available to administer the tests. Absence means that there is an impact on everyone, not just the child who is absent.

- Make sure we are always where our teachers and other adults expect us to be



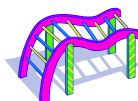
- Always use the School Gates to enter or leave the school site, not the front door
