### School Uniform Reminder

In addition to wearing full school uniform, please remember that all hair that touches the shoulders must be tied up fully, and children should not wear jewellery (except stud earrings on non-PE days, or religious items) to school. Also, nail varnish / false nails are not acceptable in school.

Wearing school uniform reinforces our rules of being Ready, Respectful and Safe.

**Girls:** Grey pinafore dress/skirt or black trousers (sky blue & white checked dress in Summer)  
 Sky blue polo shirt - with logo  
 Blue sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo  
 Plain tights in a dark colour (navy blue, black or grey)  
 White or grey socks with skirt or pinafore (white socks with summer dress)  
 Black socks with trousers

**Boys:** Grey trousers (or grey shorts in Summer)  
 Sky blue polo shirt - with logo or Sky blue cotton shirt  
 Blue sweatshirt -with logo  
 Black or grey socks (plain)

**Footwear:** Black sensible school shoes or substantial closed-in sandals (**NOT TRAINERS**)

Being dressed appropriately focusses the children (**Ready**), follows the rules (**Respectful**) and makes them identifiable as Wraysbury pupils (**Safe**).

One last reminder - Please label everything that your child brings to school!!

### Important Message From RBWM

You may have seen the recent news coverage on the increase in measles outbreaks. Measles is a highly infectious disease, especially within schools, and can be very serious. NHS England has launched a national MMR catch-up campaign. Over the next few months, children aged 6 to 11 who are missing one or two doses of the MMR vaccine will be invited to contact their GP practice to check their immunisation history and book an appointment for the MMR vaccination. [Your local Children's Immunisation Team](#) will also be holding local community clinics for 6- to 11-year-olds.


