Don't forget that Gap Club is available for Breakfast club if you are struggling to get here on time due to other school drop offs. Full details are available on the school website.

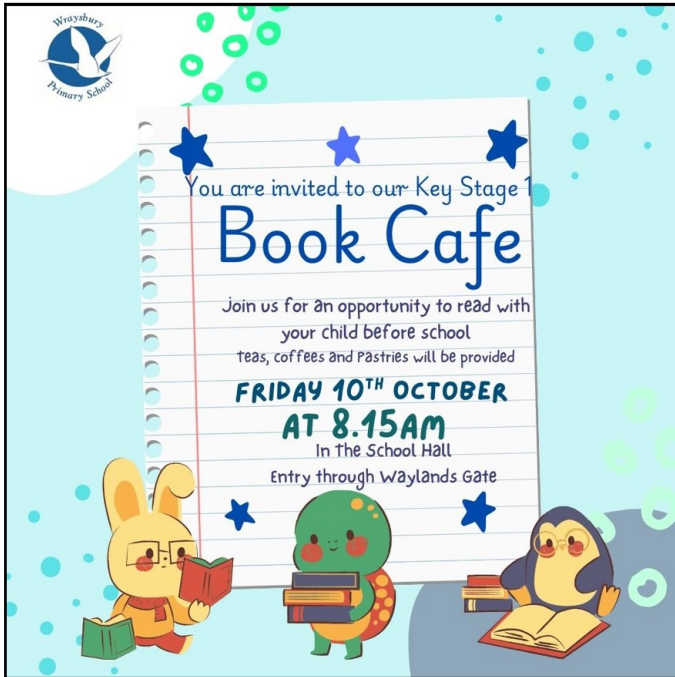


Reminders.....

- * Parents should not enter the building other than through the office. This includes at the end of the day. KS2 children finish at 3:20 and it is a safeguarding risk if adults are in school, unaccompanied. Adults seen in the building will be asked to leave immediately unless wearing a lanyard.
- * Full school uniform must be worn to school everyday, including black shoes. Our policy is grey skirts, so please correct this as soon as possible if your child is wearing a black one.
- * No make-up or jewellery (unless for religious reasons) should be worn in school including nail varnish or false nails.
- * Water bottles should be brought to school everyday. Bottles should be plastic with a sports lid, and contain plain water only.
- * Hair touching or past the shoulders must be completely tied back everyday. This is a safety precaution, and also helps prevent the spread of nits! Children whose hair is down will be asked to tie it back.

School Meals

The lunch choices for week commencing **Monday 6th October 2025** are **Week 1** of the Spring Summer Menu. Plain pasta is available on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, and jacket potatoes are served on Tuesday and Thursday. Both come with a selection of toppings.

School Meals cost £2.92 per day, and we ask that accounts are kept in credit. There is a reminder function that can be set up on the Scopay system, which will alert you if your child's balance falls below an amount set by you. The menu is available on the website. If you are able to make choices in advance (up to the night before), it saves the children time during registration, and you can also encourage your child to try something new! Please speak to the office if you are having any problems accessing Scopay. This menu will continue until October half term, when a new version will be sent home.
