Guidance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Further Guidance was released to schools on 4th November 2020 for the 9th November The Government continues to prioritise the wellbeing and long term futures of children and will not be closing Early Years settings or schools
Pupil and Staff Safety, what we are doing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensuring people who are ill stay at home continuation of a robust hand and respiratory hygiene enhanced cleaning arrangements active engagement with NHS Test and Trace reducing contacts and maximising distancing between those in school, wherever possible, and minimising potential for contamination so far as is reasonably practicable
Bubbles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Year Group bubbles
Attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All children should be attending school. If a child cannot attend for any reason the child's parent MUST ring the school office and explain the reason for absence. The risk to children of becoming ill from COVID -19 is very low and there are negative health impacts of being out of school
Before leaving home in the morning	<p>Please check for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a high temperature a new, continuous cough a loss of, or change to the sense of smell or taste <p>If any of these symptoms are evident do not send them to school, contact the school office on 01784 482603 or email wraysbury@rbwm.org.uk</p>
Transport to school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please walk Please park away from the school site – it will be busy Please check the home school transport risk assessment and guidance
Gates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use the gate nearest to your home When queueing at the gate we ask you to please to now wear a mask.
Morning drop off From 8.40-8.55	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please do not enter the site
Pick Up Rec – 2.50 Y1 and 2 3.00 pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please be prompt Please stand by the Year group marker Please receive your child and leave the gate area asap Please move to the year group marker if you are collecting a KS2 child 1 parent please
Pick up Y3-6 3.10 pm.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please stand by the Year group marker Please receive your child and leave the gate area asap Y6 preferably to exit with a gate pass and meet up with parents locally or walk home Minibus children out the pedestrian gate at Waylands Y3-6 with younger siblings out Other Y3-6 pupils out Please avoid coming early. 1 parent please
In school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children will operate in year group bubbles Children will wash hands frequently with soap and water Children should not bring hand sanitiser to school

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children do not require masks Resources and equipment used will be individual or only shared in the bubble if absolutely necessary. Equipment will be sanitised regularly or left for 48 hours
What to bring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children <u>can</u> bring a lunch box Children should bring their own water bottle KS2 children can bring their own small pencil case – but must not share their equipment (we will have individual equipment sets available) Children should bring their PE kit in a small bag and leave it in school for the half term Children must have appropriate wet weather clothing (we will be working outside as much as possible) Children should bring their book bag/small rucksack Reading books will be sent home, but left in a box on return KS2 Children should bring a snack for break time
Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Meetings with members of staff will now only take place in person if absolutely necessary, be by prior arrangement only please email Wraysbury@rbwm.org.uk or telephone the office 01784 482603 to make arrangements. Please keep face to face conversations to a minimum at the school gates. Microsoft Teams and telephone conversations will be used
School Office	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continues to be open but please wait to be let in We will only have 1 or 2 people in at one time A post box will be outside the front door for the dropping off of slips/letters for the office
Behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> children should be aware that unhygienic behaviour is taken very seriously. A child may be sent home if they are unable to follow the instructions and risk the safety of others Parents are asked to be respectful towards school staff in this difficult time, abuse will not be tolerated
School Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All children are expected to wear full school uniform and change it daily if possible The PTFA will be selling "Good as new uniform" regularly.

Exams	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Exams will take place this year; SATs for Y2 and 6 and Times Tables for Y4 Phonic Screening takes place in December for Y2
Sport	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Unfortunately we are not able to take part in face to face sporting competitions but we have Intra House events planned and virtual competitions planned against other schools We are still able to work with the external coaches from the Windsor Sport Partnership 😊
