Social distancing	Coronavirus transmitted to others	M	Generally known that the COVID-19 risk to children is significantly lower, and the symptoms are not as severe as they are for adults  If a child shows any symptoms, or have been in contact with someone who has shown symptoms, they should not attend  Only two year group picnics will take place at any one time. Different year groups will be in different areas  Each year group will enter and exit by different gates – parents and children will be asked to line up socially distanced  Any parents coming to the front door will be asked to go to the appropriate gate  Cones will be placed outside the gates to aid social distance queuing (AR/SJ)  Year groups will not mix with any other year group  Picnics will be outside unless very poor weather. Gazebos will be available  Children will be sat 1m+ apart outside whilst having their lunch and will be asked not to share their food  Year groups not having their picnic will have their break in a different area of the school Children going to the ice cream van will be accompanied by staff  Allergy sheet for each year group will be given to relevant teacher (dairy/lactose etc)  When being dismissed to parents, children to sit socially distanced to side of gate, children dismissed 1 or 2 at a time	Timetable set out  See rota	L
