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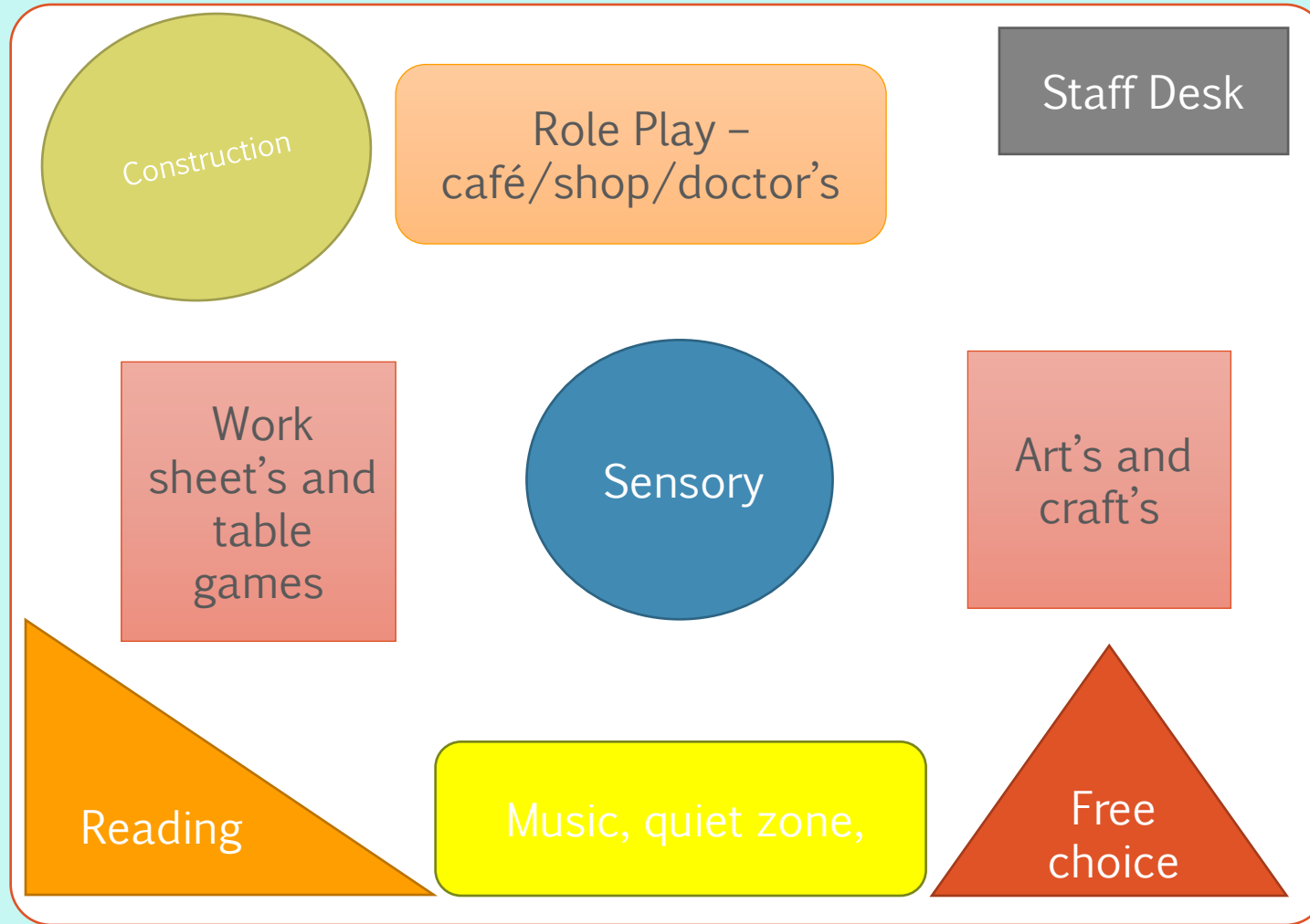

Creative and Emotional

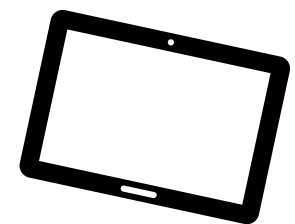
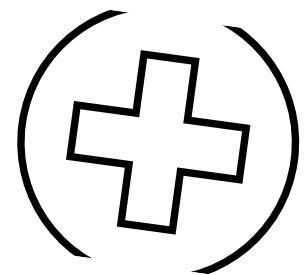
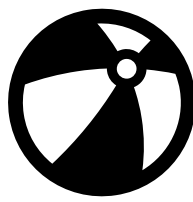
Each room will use at least:
