Historic knowledge

Children will learn significant aspects of the history of the wider world: the nature of ancient civilisations; the expansion and dissolution of empires; achievements and follies of mankind. They will explore a study of Greek life and achievements and the influence of Greek civilisation on the western world.

recognise how Athenian democracy worked by participating in a debate
