Don't forget that Gap Club is available for Breakfast club. Maybe this could reduce the morning stress??




Reminders.....



- * No parents should enter the school other than through the office. This also applies at the end of the day. This is to ensure the safety of all of the children.
- * The area in front of the gates should not be used for dropping children into school. The traffic cameras are in operation.
- * Please make sure your child brings a coat to school every day. The weather is very changeable and the children go outside even if it is wet.
- * No make-up or jewellery (unless for religious reasons) should be worn in school including nail varnish or false nails.
- * Water bottles should be brought to school everyday. Bottles should be plastic with a sports lid, and contain plain water only.
- * Hair touching or past the shoulders must be completely tied back everyday. This is a safety precaution, and also helps prevent the spread of headlice!

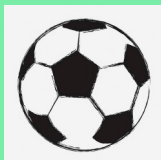

School Meals
