Throughout the year, children in Year 1 observe and investigate seasonal changes. As part of their learning, we would like to send home 'Barry the Bear'. Each child in the class will get a turn to take the bear home on a Friday and return to school on Monday. Alongside Barry the Bear, will be a notebook so that the following information can be recorded:
