School Meals


The lunch choices for week commencing Monday 8th September 2025 are Week 3 of the Spring Summer Menu. Plain pasta is available on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, and jacket potatoes are served on Tuesday and Thursday. Both come with a selection of toppings. Puddings may vary on Monday and Tuesday to use up any ingredients that won't keep until September.

School Meals cost £2.79 per day, and we ask that accounts are kept in credit. There is a reminder function that can be set up on the Scopay system, which will alert you if your child's balance falls below an amount set by you. If your child is in Year 6 or leaving the school at the end of term, please make sure your account is cleared. The menu is available on the website. If you are able to make choices in advance (up to the night before), it saves the children time during registration, and you can also encourage your child to try something new!


