Reminders.....


- * All children are required to wear black school shoes, and not trainers. If your child is not wearing the correct footwear, please rectify this at the weekend.

- * We are a nut-free school. Please make sure there are no items containing nuts in packed lunches. This includes Nutella and Cherry Bakewells!!



School Meals

The lunch choices for week commencing **Monday** 12th May 2025 are Week 1 of the new Spring Summer Menu. Plain pasta is available on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, and jacket potatoes are served on Tuesday and Thursday. Both come with a selection of toppings. Unfortunately, due to technical issues, the kitchen is unable to serve rice, so will offer wedges or pasta as a side dish on Tuesday.

From 1st April 2025, School Meals cost £2.79 per day, and we ask that accounts are kept in credit. There is a reminder function that can be set up on the Scopay system, which will alert you if your child's balance falls below an amount set by you. The new menu, that started after the Easter break, is available on the website. If you are able to make choices in advance (up to the night before), it saves the children time during registration, and you can also encourage your child to try something new!
