What a strange Spring/Summer term it has been! We would love to say farewell to you all and celebrate the end of the academic year with a "socially distanced picnic and ice-cream van"!

We are inviting **all** our pupils to be part of this, if you would like to be! As you can imagine this is very tricky to organise but with careful planning and a robust risk assessment (on our website in whole school letters) we have done it. Here are the important points that we ask **EVERYONE** to follow please:

Children not currently accessing school:

- Come on your allotted day and at the specified time for your Year group (see below)
- Please use the specified gate
- **An adult must accompany the child and answer the Health Questions**
- Come **OUT** of school uniform
- Bring a picnic (no glass bottles, cans, fizzy drinks or nut products)
- Bring a small rug, mat or blanket to sit on
- Bring a bag or 2 (there is stuff for you to take home)
- **PLEASE bring BACK any books or other equipment that belongs to the School (reading books, Library books, etc) THANK YOU!**

Children currently in school:

- **The picnic will fall within the school day**
- Come **OUT** of school uniform on the day of **your Year group picnic**
- You will be able to order a grab bag lunch for the day of your picnic or bring a picnic from home
- Please order your grab bag **w/c 13th July** on the form that will be available for you
- Bring a small rug, mat or blanket to sit on
- Bring a bag or 2 (there is stuff for you to take home)
- **PLEASE bring BACK any books or other equipment that belongs to School (reading books, Library books, etc) any time next week.**

*We have arranged for an ice cream van to come onto the school site for both the picnics. The PTFA have kindly agreed to fund an ice cream/ice lolly for all the children. Thank you PTFA!☺. We will offer the children who are unable to have the ice cream (due to dietary requirements) a lolly.

As part of the picnic the children will meet their new class teacher for September and of course there will be the chance for the children to say goodbye and a huge thank you to their current teacher and TAs.

Parents are welcome to say good bye to us at pick up, we just ask you to please abide by social distancing!

We really hope that your child will be able to join us, especially if they haven't been back in school. You don't need to book to attend, registers will be taken at the gate on entry! If it is wet then it will still go ahead but we will spread the children out inside!
