Personal Social and Emotional	Can you make a kindness jar/pot? Find a pot/jar label it and every time you or someone else does something kind, write it on a piece of paper (or get your adult to) and see if you can fill the jar up to the top.
Physical	Can you get dressed (by yourself) by the time your adult has counted to 30? Can you beat this time the next day? Practise forming the letter 'g' correctly (see Physical Development Overview)

How many can you find and name?</p> <p><b>Writing:</b> Make an Easter card for a member of your family and write a message inside</p> <p><b>Reading</b> Can you read the Easter Bunny's words? - see PowerPoint Helpful hint -each one contains one or more digraph</p>

Maths	 <p>Can you make your own chicks and egg?  Roll the dice twice to see how many chicks are in the egg  e.g <math>3+5=</math>  Can you write the calculation?</p>
