Parent Feedback Survey April 2025

Dear Parents and Carers

You may remember that just before the Easter, we held a survey asking for views on certain aspects of the school. Thank you to everyone who took the time to respond, and we are pleased to share the results with you. We had 48 responses and each response is, therefore, worth approx. 2% There is a full table over page and it was very reassuring to see that 92% of parents who responded agreed that their child felt safe in school, and 85% are happy here. As you know, we have worked really hard on behaviour over the last 2 years, and such a wide range of people, internally and externally, have commented on the huge improvements they have seen. It was particularly pleasing to see that 71% of parents who responded think behavior is good.

We have taken note of the response to the question regarding 'wider personal development' for the children. As a school, this has always been a strength and so we took the opportunity to share all our work with you in a workshop that Mrs Khan and Mr Darbon ran before half term. We have also been considering your responses to the question of a good range of subjects being available at the school.
