Consultation on new provision for children with special educational needs

The Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead is proposing to open new facilities for children with special educational needs. One of the options they are considering is the opening of a Resource Base at Wraysbury Primary School. This would be for children with social communication difficulties and related behaviours. The Royal Borough is considering four other options alongside this one.

As a school we are delighted that we are being considered as one of the sites for the new provision as we are often frustrated by the difficulties faced by our staff and families in accessing the support that our children need.

Until now, there has been no provision in the Borough for Primary aged pupils who need help and support. Added to this our location has meant that staff and families often have to travel to Maidenhead to access services and support, and specialist staff have to come out from Maidenhead to Wraysbury in order to support us.

Both the Borough and the Federation now want to hear your views on these proposals. Please can we ask for your help and support in completing the consultation and giving your views, even if you do not need to access this support for your child.
