Spring Curriculum Topic Web

This term Year 5 will be learning all about the Ancient Greeks in Topic lessons and Year 6 will be studying a new topic, Our Changing World. In addition to the topic web, as a team, we have in depth planning meetings of these subjects which we use on a weekly basis to guide our teaching. Physical Education

Brain Builder Homework and Doodlemaths

Brain Builders and Doodlemaths will continue to be set this term for Year 5. However, Year 6 have started revision tasks for homework, please be aware that these will be <u>set on a Friday and due</u> <u>in, with set tasks fully completed, on the following Friday.</u>

Brain Builder homework for year 5 is still being set on a *Friday* and will be due back into school, completed 10 days later, on the **following** *Monday*. Please support us by finding your child the time and place to complete a task to a <u>high standard</u>. If there is a <u>genuine reason</u> for any Brain Builder or Doodlemaths task not being completed, please write a note, otherwise loss of Golden Time will continue until it is returned to the class teacher.

Reading

In addition to the Brain Builder, children are also expected to read at home. Reading practice needs to take place <u>daily</u> for at least 10-15minutes. Reading in Upper Juniors is more than just reading the words on the page, the children need to really understand what they are reading and work on their inference and deduction skills. At the beginning of the year I sent home some questions in homework diaries to help you with this. Once your child has read then time should be spent with an adult discussing the text.

Reading Diaries need to be signed by an adult to show that reading has taken place. You can write any notes regarding questioning that has taken place in the reading diary as well. Loss of Golden Time will occur if children are not reading at home.

School Shoes

Can I please take this opportunity to remind you that the children should not be wearing trainers to school, this is not part of our school uniform and the children should all be wearing black shoes.

Class Assemblies

Class assemblies on Friday afternoons continue to be a feature this year and we will offer you the opportunity to see some of the work your child's class has undertaken. A letter will be sent home when the assembly is due.

Residential

For all those children coming on the residential trip in June please check for reminders this term about payment dates. I will be sending home medical consent forms in the coming weeks that need to be completed and returned to school as soon as possible.
