Reminders.....



- * Children should be wearing suitable, black, shoes to school and not trainers. It is important that they have trainers with them for PE or to change into if shoes get wet or muddy, but they must not be wearing them as school shoes.
- * Please park considerately at the start and end of the day. Avoid blocking drive-ways and always leave access that may be required by emergency vehicles
- * It's great to see the children bringing water bottles into school, but please make sure that they seal properly to reduce the risk of spillage, and use plastic bottles if possible. Some of the metal bottles are very heavy once filled.

Don't be a disappearing act this winter




Your bike should have:

- a white light on the front, with a white reflector
- a red light on the back, with a red reflector
- amber reflectors on each pedal (spoke reflectors also helpful)

Wearing bright, high vis and reflective clothing will make you more visible on the road

It is a legal requirement to make sure you ride with the correct lights when it is dark

Earache (Children aged 1 to 17 years)

Did you know that community pharmacies can now offer clinical appointments with medication available (if required) for **five clinical conditions** particularly relevant to school age children?

- Ear ache (children aged 1-17)
- Sore throat (over 5s)
- Infected insect bites (over 1s)
- Impetigo (over 1s)
- Sinusitis (over 12s)

GP practices are busy and making an appointment with them is not always necessary!

When your child is ill with any of these conditions, head straight to your local community pharmacy where you can have a consultation with a trained clinical professional and receive advice, guidance and even medication if it's needed. Lets get your child on the road to recovery as soon as possible.



Infected Insect Bite or Impetigo (Children and adults age 1 and over)



Sore throat (Children and adults age 5 and up)

The majority of Frimley Health and Care community pharmacies offer the Pharmacy First service.
