Summer Curriculum Topic Web

This term Year 6 will be studying 'The Mayan Civilisation' and Year 5 will be looking at 'Amazing Archaeology - Stone Age to Iron Age.' We have some very exciting plans which we are sure the children will really enjoy. In order for you to support your child's learning at home please find attached to this newsletter a topic web. This briefly shows you the areas we will be covering within this Topic. In addition to this Topic web, as a team, we have planning meetings of these subjects which we use on a weekly basis to guide our teaching. If you have any resources or expertise in these subjects, we would welcome the opportunity for you to share them with us.

Physical Education

This term sees the children begin their swimming lessons as part of their physical education. We are hoping that the children will start swimming soon, but we will keep you updated and let you know your child's swimming day. The Upper Junior Outdoor PE timetable is as follows:

Your children will require a clean kit each week and these should also be clearly named.

- Outdoor PE white t-shirt, navy shorts, trainers, dark tracksuit for colder weather conditions (not their school jumper)
- Swimming Kit a swimsuit (one-piece costume for girls and above knee length shorts for boys not long Bermuda-style), a towel and some suitable shoes for pool side or emergencies e.g. crocs, flipflops.

Please observe the school rules for jewellery and ensure that, for safety reasons, only small stud earrings may be worn but must be removed for PE or swimming. Only permitted religious bangles may be worn and MUST be covered with a sweatband for PE and removed for swimming.

School Shoes

Can I please take this opportunity to remind you that the children should not be wearing trainers to school. This is not part of our school uniform and the children should all be wearing black shoes.

Pencil Cases

As I have mentioned in previous letters, the children only require a small pencil case in Upper Juniors. This should contain their handwriting pen, pencil, rubber, small ruler, barrel sharpener, small glue stick and a selection of colouring pencils or pens. If the pencil case does not fit in their tray then we will send it home.

Water Bottles

As the weather gets warmer over the coming weeks please remember to send in a water bottle for your child. You can purchase these from the school office for £1.50.

Reading

Children should be reading at home every night and this should be recorded in their homework diary. Children need to ensure their home diary is in school every day and is handed in according to the routines within their classroom.

Assessments

May is a very important month for your child's formal assessments. Year 6 will be sitting their Reading, Writing and Maths SATs examinations in the week beginning **Monday 14th May**. Punctual attendance leading up to and during this week is vital. Year 5 will be sitting their summer term assessments later on in the term. The results of all the children's assessments will be passed on to you in their end of year reports.

Social Network Sites and the Internet

It is occasionally a place for inappropriate interaction or unkind comments being made by some pupils in our school, or beyond. This is proving particularly common with 'Instagram' and 'Snapchat', the results of which can upset and intrude on pupils' education. If you allow your child to sign up to these websites, or use them at other children's homes, please be aware of your role of responsibility and ensure that you have full access by knowing your child's password and being able to monitor their history.
