We really hope you can come along to the meeting next week. This is a great chance to meet your child's teacher and other members of staff who may work with them this year. The teams will be happy to share some of the exciting things that they have planned for the year, and give you tips and hints to help you support your child's learning.

EYFS Phonics Workshop

This informative session is so important to help support your child as they start their learning journey. There will be a similar session for Maths on 26th September, and both will give you plenty of ways to support your child at home.

School Meals

The lunch choices for week commencing **Monday 15th September 2025** are **Week 1** of the Spring Summer Menu. Plain pasta is available on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, and jacket potatoes are served on Tuesday and Thursday. Both come with a selection of toppings.

School Meals cost £2.92 per day, and we ask that accounts are kept in credit. There is a reminder function that can be set up on the Scopay system, which will alert you if your child's balance falls below an amount set by you. The menu is available on the website. If you are able to make choices in advance (up to the night before), it saves the children time during registration, and you can also encourage your child to try something new! Online registration details will be sent home next week to any new parents.

This menu will continue until October half term, when a new version will be sent home.

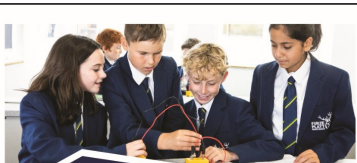
