Year 3 'Swords and Sandals' Workshop

Dear Parents and Carers of Year 3,

I am very excited to share with you that this term we will be having a visiting workshop for Year 3, on the morning of Monday 16th September 2019 in the classroom. This links with our new topic 'Swords and Sandals' and also with the work we will be completing in English. **No payment** will be required, as all costs have been kindly met by the school. The workshop is run by the Chertsey Museum and gives pupils a chance to handle original Roman archaeology and replica items. The sessions concentrate on everyday life in Roman Britain. All sessions involve an object based talk which uses original items and replicas to help them find out about the Romans.

The children will:

- Understand how we learn about the past using artefacts.
- Gain understanding about how to handle, care and appreciate original and replica objects
- Learn about the differences between the Celts and the Romans
- Understand what everyday life was like for a Roman citizen.

This is a very exciting opportunity for the children and will provide an informative and memorable start to this fascinating topic.
