#### Reminders.

- No make-up or jewellery (unless for religious reasons) should be worn in school in-cluding nail varnish or false nails.

- Hair touching or past the shoulders must be completely tied back everyday. This is a safety precaution, and also helps prevent the spread of nits! Children whose hair is down will be asked to tie it back




