Reminders.....

- * Parents should not enter the building other than through the office. This includes at the end of the day. KS2 children finish at 3:20 and it is a safeguarding risk if adults are in school, unaccompanied. Adults seen in the building will be asked to leave immediately unless wearing a lanyard.
- * Full school uniform must be worn to school everyday, including black shoes.
- * No make-up or jewellery (unless for religious reasons) should be worn in school including nail varnish or false nails.
- * Water bottles should be brought to school everyday. Bottles should be plastic with a sports lid, and contain plain water only.
- * Hair touching or past the shoulders must be completely tied back everyday. This is a safety precaution, and also helps prevent the spread of nits! Children whose hair is down will be asked to tie it back.
- * We are a nut-free school, so please no nuts or nut-based products in school.

School Meals

The lunch choices for week commencing **Monday 10th November 2025** are **Week 2** of the new Autumn Winter Menu. Plain pasta is available on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, and jacket potatoes are served on Tuesday and Thursday. School Meals cost £2.92 per day, and we ask that accounts are kept in credit.
