Dear parents and carers



We are now using the award-winning DoodleEnglish with your child's class! You'll find your child's pass attached which contains their username and password.

Simply follow these steps to make sure your child is ready to make the most of DoodleEnglish:

- Download the DoodleEnglish and the DoodleSpell apps
- Ask your child to sign in using the details attached (remember, it's case sensitive!)
- If you are not already linked to your child, tap on the Grown Ups section and follow the instructions there to link yourself to your child
- Work with your child to go through the set up phase if they're in EYFS or KS1
- Let your child work through their X-a-day exercise and/or new words activity without any help encourage them to do it independently and if they're really unsure, guess!
- Log in to <u>www.parents.doodlemaths.com</u> with your Grown Ups username and password. Hover over the DoodleMaths logo in the top left corner and change the dashboard to DoodleEnglish. Click on Monitor Live so you can see how your child is doing as they complete their exercise -Download the Parent Connect app you can see a snapshot of what your children are doing.

- Will help children make big improvements in both their ability and confidence in literacy - using for 10 minutes a day has helped children make 3 month's progress in just 1 month.
- Learns what your child's strengths are, and what they need to work on, then builds a
