As a school inclusivity is very important to us and is one of our core values. We are striving to be even more accessible and inclusive. Part of the feedback received from the PINS project focused on provision of clubs for Neurodivergent children.

Below you will find details of parent paid after school clubs and teacher run free clubs that will be taking place this term. The parent paid clubs are delivered by external companies, but they work hard to ensure that the same coaches deliver the sessions so that your child can build a relationship with them. There is also a bit more of an explanation of what the club consists of so that you can talk to your child about what to expect if they took part in the club. KS1 Football: Football skills and competitive matches, played outside on the field on Fridays

KS2 Football: Football drills and skills and competitive matches, played outside on the field on Wednesdays.

KS1 Multisport: A range of different sports, both indoors and outdoors on Thursdays.

KS2 Dodgeball: A fast and fun indoor game where you throw balls at the other team to get them out. Can be loud and fast paced – Friday sessions

Free Teacher Run Clubs (Run for 7 weeks)

EYFS Football and Multisports: Mr Panea delivering fun football skills, mixed with other sports outside on the field.

KS1 Scatterball: Mrs McGregor introducing the children to Scatterball; 1 player “scatters” different items around the pitch, then runs around the bases whilst the other team collect all the items into a hoop. The first team back wins a rounder.

KS2 Card and Board Games: Miss Carty will give the children opportunities to learn the rules of different board and card games – some traditional, some more modern.

KS2 Neurodivergent Lego/Brick club: Get creative with Lego, in a calm classroom with a small group and Mrs Basra – for invited children only.
